

Guide to remotely access e-resources subscribed by MAHE

Authentication:

- Remote access to the subscribed e-resources of TAPMI and MAHE, Manipal, is available to all users—including students, researchers, and faculty members of TAPMI at the campus through their OpenAthens account.
- OpenAthens accounts are linked to the user's **Office 365 Outlook email (manipal.edu / learner.manipal.edu)**.
- Authentication for eligible and authorized users has been carried out through Office 365 (manipal.edu/learner.manipal.edu) via OpenAthens, based on the lists provided by PGP.

What is OpenAthens?

- OpenAthens provides a Single Sign-On (SSO) solution that enables library users to remotely access all subscribed e-resources, including online databases, journals, and e-books, using their Office 365 credentials (learner.manipal.edu/manipal.edu).
- The system is integrated with Microsoft Office, which helps prevent unauthorized access to these e-resources.
- OpenAthens offers a seamless single sign-on experience that is not dependent on any specific IP range.
- Additionally, users can access the full text of subscribed e-resources directly through the publishers' websites, with their OpenAthens username and password facilitate access. This system allows users to navigate multiple platforms using a single set of login details.

Kindly follow the following procedure to access the resources remotely:

- Go to <https://www.openathens.net/>
- Click on **Login** (right-side corner).
- Next, click on **'Login to My Athens.'**
- On the next sign-in page, you will be asked to choose or search for your institution (**in the search bar, look for TAPMI Library**).
- On the next page, click **'MAHE University Microsoft Azure'**, Sign in using your Office 365 credentials at manipal.edu/learner.manipal.edu to access the platform, and log in with your MAHE credentials.

Note:

1. If the administrator has not granted you permission, an error message appears following the selection of the TAPMI Library. Kindly write to librarian.tapmi@manipal.edu to have your email address added and grant permission to access resources through Open Athens.
2. TAPMI subscribed databases can also be accessed through the TAPMI intranet (<http://intranet.tapmi.edu.in/>) under the **'Library'** tab in the menu.
